FRESHMAN YEAR CHRISTIAN SERVICE PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Freshmen

will complete:

30 hours of Service

Required to complete at least, but not limited to, half of the service hours (15) and submit service verification sheets by the end of the first semester. Student must complete the remaining hours of service, with verification sheets, by the end of the second semester.

Service projects should be chosen to express commitment in the following areas:

- Service on the Campus of Servite High School
- Service at Parish/Faith Based Community or Civic Community
- Christian Service/Charitable Service (Feeding the homeless, working at a soup kitchen, caring for the elderly or someone with special needs, etc.)

It is important that your Christian service hours come from several different sources. We welcome hours that are performed on campus, but we also stress the importance of hours that are served off-campus. It is important to serve your parish or faith based community, as well as your local civic community. Please contact the Campus Ministry Office with any questions regarding service hours and opportunities.

Please note the following:

- Christian Service Forms must be completely filled out and turned in to the Campus Ministry Office within 30 days of the service project or the hours will be voided.
- Hours completed above the required yearly total will not apply to the following year's requirement. They will be added to a student's accumulated service hours for college applications.
- Underclassmen who have not completed the required hours by the end of each school year, will not receive their class schedule for the following year.
- Seniors will not receive their diploma until all required hours (100 total) are both completed and recorded.
