### Directions:

- 2) Then, complete **one** of the following activities. **Due the first week of school.**

### Activities:

- 1) Create **three** separate one-pagers to represent **three** different scenes, floors, or chapters in the novel.

(A one-pager is an 8 ½ X 11 blank piece of paper that the student fills up ***completely*** with **powerful words/lines and key images or symbols** from a scene/floor/chapter in a novel). **Please see the examples for guidance.**

- 2) Respond to the following questions thoughtfully:
  - a) What did you enjoy about the novel? Be specific! Give examples! (For example, if you answer, "I like Reynolds' style," then give a specific example of a page that represents his style).
  - b) Who were your favorite characters and why? Be specific!
  - c) Are there any other books/texts/movies/etc. that you could connect it to?
  - d) Would you suggest others read this novel too? Why or why not?
  - e) Would you tweak or change anything about the book? If so, what? If not, *why* not?
  - f) What were your major thoughts and takeaways from the book?
