**Location:**

This home Water Polo game will be played at the Fr. Fitzpatrick Aquatic Center on the campus of Servite High School located at 1952 W. La Palma Ave, Anaheim California, 92801.

**Buses:**

All buses will drop off, park and pick up team on La Palma Avenue just prior to the school marquis.

**Locker Facility:**

Due to COVID-19 protocol, no locker rooms are available for team or spectator use.

**Medical:**

Servite High School Athletic Trainer will be on site at all home games.

Anaheim Memorial Hospital is located directly East of Servite High School, off of La Palma Ave. approximately one mile.

**Cheerleaders:**

Due to COVID-19 protocol, No Cheerleaders will be allowed

**Security:**

Servite High School Administration, Faculty, and Staff will be present at all home water polo games. Visiting teams are encouraged to provide supervision for visitor's stands. A 3<sup>rd</sup> party security outfit may also be used for games.

**Check-in Procedures:**

A roster of all players, coaches and attending administrators must be sent to [jhartmann@servitehs.org](mailto:jhartmann@servitehs.org) and [acoffman@servitehs.org](mailto:acoffman@servitehs.org) one full day prior to competition.

Screening of players will be performed by medical staff (athletic trainers, nurses) or other administration and coaches.

Screening will be done as such:

- Temperature Checks
- Symptoms Questionnaire

**Home Team:**

Athletes will already have been screened by the screening process to be at school.

**Away Team:**

Athletes and coaches will be screened prior to entering busses or vans going to the venue. All other support staff, administration, and coaches arriving at Servite will go through the same screening process (i.e. temperature checks and symptoms questionnaire). Any athlete, coach, support staff, or administration will not be permitted to attend an event if they have any of the following symptoms as outlined by the CDC.

**Entering and exiting:**

**Visitors** will enter and exit the pool deck through the North entrance (gate closest to scoreboard) and will use the North side of the pool deck for their sideline

**Home** team will enter and exit the pool deck through the South entrance and will use the South side of the pool deck for their sideline. (\*Note-teams will **not** switch sides at half or quarter)

**Face covering and Sanitization:**

- All persons in attendance must wear a face covering at all times, except when in the water.
- All persons must sanitize or wash their hands upon entering and exiting venues/events.

**Locker rooms:**

Locker rooms **will not** be provided for home or away teams. All athletes, coaches and support staff must arrive ready for warm-ups and competition.

**Hydration:**

Athletes, coaches, support staff and administration are responsible for bringing their own hydration for the duration of the event. Sharing of water, food, other drinks **will NOT** be allowed.

**Fans:**

At this time, fans will be limited to two (2) household members per athlete. Visiting team fans will use the same entrance and exit as the visiting team players (North gates by the scoreboard). Home team fans will use the same entrance as exit as the home team players (South gates by the restrooms). Once the game is over, all players and fans must exit the facility, and the bleachers and benches will be sanitized before the following teams and fans can enter the gates.

**Screening:** Fans will be screened before being allowed in the pool gates, either by the security/nurses at the front of the school, or by the support staff at the entrances to the pool.

**Restrooms:**

Located outside of the pool deck. Male and female facilities available.
